| 3) Moses heard the voice of God <ul style="list-style-type: none">• He had an intimate relationship with God | Exodus 3: 4; 6: 1

| 4) God gave Moses the task that was already on his heart | Exodus 3: 7 – 10 |
| 5) Moses doubted his ability but God was confident in him | Exodus 3: 11 – 12; 4: 1 – 17

| 6) Moses' leadership was under God's authority | Exodus 3: 13 – 15 |
| 7) In times of trouble Moses turned to the Lord <ul style="list-style-type: none">• He didn't retaliate but trusted God | Exodus 5: 21 – 22; 15: 22 – 25

| 8) Moses stood up for his people <ul style="list-style-type: none">• He interceded for them when they were wrong | Exodus 32: 7 – 14

| 9) Moses listened to counsel <ul style="list-style-type: none">• He was teachable | Exodus 18: 13 – 26 |
| 10) Moses mentored a future leader | Exodus 33: 11
