- 1) Who wrote the book of Romans? (v. 1)
- 2) How does he describe himself? (v. 1)
- 3) Name 4 aspects of the gospel described in verses 2 & 3
- 4) Name 4 aspects of Jesus as mentioned in verses 3 & 4
- 5) What have we received through Jesus, and to do what, and for what? (v.5)
- 6) Are those he's writing to in Rome Jews or Gentiles? (v.6)
- 7) What are those in Rome called for? (v. 6 & 7)
  - How else does God view them?
- 8) Grace and peace to you from God our Father and from the Lord Jesus Christ. (v.7)
  - This phrase is the standard greeting by Paul. He uses it in each of his thirteen canonical letters.
- 9) Why did Paul thank God? (v. 8)
- 10) What did Paul do in serving God? (v.9)
- 11) What is God a witness of? (vs. 9 & 10)
- 12) Why did Paul long to see the believers in Rome? There are two points in the answer (vs. 11 & 12)
- 13) Why did Paul plan to visit Rome many times? (v. 13)
- 14) Who was Paul obligated to in Rome and what was he eager to do? (vs. 14 15)
- 15) Why was Paul not ashamed of the Gospel? (v. 16)
- 16) What is revealed through the Gospel? V. 17) Read Habakkuk 2: 4
- 17) What is being revealed against all godlessness and wickedness of people? (v. 18)
   Note that the present continuous passive tense is used here. What does that tell us?
   Read Revelation 20: 11 15
   What is the difference between the wrath of God being revealed in Romans 1 and Revelation 20?
- 18) What do wicked people do to the truth? (v. 18) What does that mean?
- 19) Will people have an excuse of not knowing about God and his righteousness? (vs. 19-20) Please elaborate from the verses
- 20) Do wicked people know God? What did they do and what happened to their hearts? (v.21)

- 21) In claiming to be wise what did they become and what did they do? (vs. 22-23) What command did they break in doing this? Read Exodus 20: 1-4
- 22) What did God do? (v. 24)

  Does this mean that God permits wickedness?
- 23) How did people exchange the truth of God for a lie? (v. 25) Why is it a lie?
- 24) What were the shameful lusts that God gave them over to? (vs. 26-27) What are the consequences thereof? Read Leviticus 18: 22; 1 Corinthians 6: 9-10; 1 Timothy 1: 8-10
- 25) Why did God give them over to a depraved mind? What did they do? (v. 28)
- 26) What actions did they start doing having a depraved mind? (vs. 29 31)
- 27) Did they know the consequences of their actions? What are those consequences? (v. 32) Is it only doing wicked actions that is condemned?
